### Regional integration in Northern Europe in a nutshell

- Scandinavia squeezed between Russia and Prussia/Germany
- Scandinavism/Nordism has roots in the mid-19<sup>th</sup> century
- Nordic Council estd. in 1952
- But: SE, FI outside NATO; and NO, IS outside EU (though rich cooperation)
- Current themes: climate solutions, bioeconomy, gender equality, safe cities, Nordic food, reg. branding





### Regional integration in East-Central Europe in a nutshell

- ECE squeezed between Russia, Germany (and formerly the Ottoman Empire)
- Cooperation dates back to 1335, but long periods of discontinuity
- Visegrad Group estd. in 1991, for joining EU, NATO
- 2004–2014: low intensity cooperation
- Since 2015, high intensity
- Main current/recent issues
  - **>** EU migration policy
  - $\rightarrow$  dual food quality in the EU
  - → integration of West Balkans
  - → agricultural policy in the EU





### Comparing the NC and the V4: future research potentials

• What have the main issues of cooperation been within the two inter-governmental organisations?

- What norms, values, and policy solutions have they been trying to export, and how successfully?
  - > Which initiatives of the two groupings were exported into the agendas of larger inter-governmental bodies; which ones were even adopted?



## Further potential questions

- How cohesive have these macro-regional initiatives been?
  - \rightarrow Have they voted together in larger inter-governmental bodies?
- To what extent have they been challenged by alternative formations?
  - > e.g. Baltic Sea Region, Weimar Triangle, Slavkov Triangle, etc.
- How do the power relations look like within the organisations? (Neither NO nor HU is the largest country within the respective group.)
- To what extent do citizens identify with such (politically) constructed spaces?
