- Established in 2012, on the basis of separate research institutions of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (HAS)
- New building on the South Buda campus of two large universities:
 - Eötvös Loránd University
 - Budapest University of Technology and Economics
- Wide though not full spectrum of sciences, even reaching over the boundaries of (natural) science
- ☐ Great possibilities of synergy, interdiplinary cooperation within the Research Centre, and with the universities

BASIC DATA



- Rounded numbers of employees (FTE, Dec. 31, 2017): 420, including 290 research staff (60 persons in the assitant staff also hold MSc or BSc degrees)
- Financial source ratio: 40-50 % national budget through the Hungarian Academy of Sciences; 50-60 % grants, industrial projects
- Lendület (Momentum) research groups: 14 (earlier and present)
- Research groups belonging to the National Brain Research Program (NAP): 8
- One research group supported by the Élvonal (Cutting Edge) program (nationally 12 groups)
