

Data Protection Policy

We are delighted that you are visiting our website and with your interest in the services that Potsdam CCI has to offer. Some information about data protection is provided below.

As a public body, we are bound by the provisions of Brandenburg's Data Protection Act. We take the greatest possible care when handling your data and will process your data in accordance with the pertinent statutory regulations. Please be aware that the transmission of data via the internet is at present essentially insecure. For data security purposes, when you access our website our servers will temporarily store data that may allow identification, e.g. IP address, date, time and pages viewed. These data will not be analysed, except in anonymised form for statistical purposes.

Cookies are also used. A cookie is a small file that is stored on your computer as soon as you visit a website. If you visit the website again, the cookie indicates that it is a repeat visit. The cookie contains only a unique number; it does not contain any personal details. The cookie is not able to identify you on third-party websites. If you do not want us to recognise your computer, please change your web browser settings so that it deletes cookies from your computer's hard drive, blocks all cookies or warns you before a cookie is stored. Further information can be found in the instructions for your web browser. We do not use IP addresses or cookies to identify you personally.

The website of Potsdam CCI contains hyperlinks to other websites that do not belong to Potsdam CCI. Potsdam CCI does not accept any liability for any breaches of data protection that may occur when you visit those sites.

If you request customer information from us (e.g. information brochures), we will save the data that you provide in electronic form while your order is being processed. The data will not be passed on to third parties.

You can withdraw your consent to the processing of your data in writing or by email to the CCI at any time with effect for the future. You also have the right to receive, free of charge and on request, information on the personal data we have stored about you.
