#### Analytical approaches applied to the study of ancient stone materials

The introduction of ever more precise and sensitive non-destructive analytical techniques in archaeology and conservation has transformed, in recent years, the way in which ancient stone artefacts are observed and interpreted. The historical-artistic and material aspects of cultural heritage are factors that, analyzed together, can provide information about its origin, manufacturing techniques and use, and they allow for the selection of compatible materials for conservation. Researchers present different innovative non-destructive and/or micro-destructive analytical approaches to the study of ancient stone materials illustrating different case studies.
